Expands health insurance coverage for behavioral health services and autism and enhances enforcement and oversight of mental health parity laws.

Prohibits pharmacy benefits managers from making certain retroactive reductions in claim payments to pharmacies.
- [A-4059](#) - Calabrese (D36)  
Requires criminal history record background checks for certain DOBI employees.

- [S-2826](#) - Bucco (R25); Greenstein (D14)  
Requires institutions of higher education to offer cats and dogs no longer used for educational, research, or scientific purposes to animal rescue organizations for adoption.

Concerns liability of direct contractors for wage claims against subcontractors.

Requires annual evaluation reports by Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development on survey responses to be obtained from certain employers that end operations in this State.
- [S-2556](#) - Singleton (D7)  
Creates Joint Apprenticeship Incentive Grant Program.
- [S-2891](#) - Lagana (D38); Singleton (D7)  
"New Jersey Secure Choice Savings Program Act"; establishes retirement savings program for certain workers; establishes standard contribution level of 6 percent.
- [SJR37](#) - Weinberg (D37)  
Designates second Tuesday in April as "Equal Pay Day."

Eliminates certain aviation fuel tax exemptions to qualifying airlines; provides funding for PATH train extension to Newark Liberty International Airport and airport improvements.

Provides for improved system for eligibility determination for Medicaid and NJ FamilyCare.

Allows deduction from New Jersey gross income of certain capital gains from sale or exchange of New Jersey qualified small business stock held for more than five years.
- [S-2454](#) - Madden (D4)  
Concerns prevailing wage requirements for certain fabrication.

Requires direct supervision of pharmacy interns and externs who administer certain injectable medications.

Prohibits consumer reporting agencies from charging certain fees related to security freezes on consumer reports.

Prohibits discrimination against cash-paying consumers.
- [A-1220](#) / [S-675](#) - McKeon (D27); Vainieri Huttle (D37); Jasey (D27); Mukherji (D33) / Bateman (R16); Vitale (D19)  
"Drama Therapists and Dance/Movement Therapists Licensing Act."

Encourages development of public electric vehicle charging infrastructure in redevelopment projects.
- [A-3797](#) - Jasey (D27); Chaparro (D33)  
Permits municipal land banking in conjunction with online property database development.
- [A-4023](#) - DeAngelo (D14)  
Provides preferences for certain businesses applying for workforce development grants.
- AJR150 - Johnson (D37); Conaway (D7)  
Designates October 8 of each year as "Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Day" in NJ.
- [S-446](#) - Addiego (R8); Madden (D4)  
Provides preferences for certain businesses applying for workforce development grants.
